DESCRIPTION / FEATURES:

FLOOR MEDICS UV CLEANER

is a specially formulated cleaner that quickly breaks down film residue of protein & minerals on the surface of swimming pools & matt surface tiles that are damaged by ultra-violet light. It cleans, rejuvenates and restore surfaces to its original condition.

USES:

 Recommended for use on granite, porcelain tiles and other acid resistance stone & tile surfaces.

AVAILABLE SIZES:

UV Cleaner is available in 1Litre or 5Litre / bottle

COVERAGE:

 Depending on dilution and condition of floors treated, approximately 200 to 2,000 sq ft. (19m2 to 200m2)

■ METHOD OF APPLICATION:

- Read entire label before using.
- TEST A SMALL AREA, according to application instructions, to determine desired results.

FLOOR:

- 1. Sweep, vacuum or dust mop the floor surface.
- 2. Mix 1 part of Floor Medics UV Cleaner to 5 parts of water for light duty cleaning such as removal of light cement & grout haze.
- 3. Apply solution onto surface, allow to dwell 1 to 2 minutes and scrub surfaces with nylon bristle brush or pads
- 4. Rinsed with water and vacuumed dry cleaned surface.

GLASS:

- 1. Clean glass with approved neutral cleaners to remove surface dust & dirt.
- 2. Apply UV cleaner onto glass using a dry towel or cotton cloth.
- Wipe or buff off immediately after each application. Do not allow excessive UV Cleaner to dry on surface as prolong exposer may etch glass.
- 4. Wash/Rinse surface with Floor Medics Neutral Cleaner to remove any remaining residue.

LIMITATIONS:

Do not allow solutions to come into contact with non-recommended surface

■ HANDLING AND STORAGE:

- Close container after each use.
- Store in original container only.
- Unused, Store product is freeze-thaw stable.



CAUTION:

- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not take internally.
- · Sweep area to remove any loose dirt or soil
- Rubber Gloves should be worn during application.
- · Contains phosphoric acid.
- INHALATION: Move to fresh air.
- **IF INGESTED**: Do not induce vomiting. Drink 1 to 2 glasses of water. Seek immediate medical attention.
- **EYE CONTACT**: Flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.
- **SKIN CONTACT**: Wash skin with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing
